This year is a busy one for Glasgow based artist, George Devlin

February sees the opening of his retrospective exhibition at Glasgow Art Club, 185 Bath Street, G2 4HU (0141 248 5210) to mark his fifty years as an artist member. This show runs from 7-23 February and displays work from the nineteen sixties to the present day. Commission on sales will be donated by the artist to the Beatson Oncology Centre as a mark of personal debt of gratitude.

On 6 March his work will feature in the group exhibition at the Bankside Gallery (0207 928 7521 and adjacent to Tate Modern) which will run to April 14 and features the results of a group of fellow R.W.S. members' working trip to Malta. After its London showing the exhibition moves to its next venue in Valletta.

May 4 is the private view day of his solo exhibition at The Scottish Gallery, 16 Dundas St., Edinburgh EH3 6HZ (0131 558 1200). This exhibition will run until 1 June and will feature upwards of fifty works.

Also in May, his work from Rajasthan will be shown with four other artists' Indian work at the Tryon Gallery at 7 Bury St., St. James's, London (0207 839 8083). These are the results of a joint working trip to Udaipur by George and four London based artists in February 2012.

In June, Devlin's works will be transported to Johannesburg for the centenary celebrations of the Everard Read Gallery, 6 Jellicoe Ave., Rosebank 2196, Jo'burg, R.S.A. (+27 11 788 4805) with whom he has exhibited (including their Cape Town Gallery) for almost twenty years
